## DONATE PORTABLE POWER STATIONS TO MEDIA IN UKRAINE

The Russian invasion army is attacking Ukraine's infrastructure, severely hindering independent news media from reporting due to a lack of electricity.

The **Ukrainian Media Fund** (UMF) is responding to requests from the **National Union of Journalists of Ukraine** (NUJU) and the **Association of Independent Regional Publishers of Ukraine** (AIRPU). These organizations represent thousands of journalists and dozens of digital and print news media outlets.

UMF is now appealing to you, the leading publishing houses in the Nordics, to generously donate essential equipment for the war zone. UMF will arrange transportation to Ukraine via Poland, and our trusted local partners — vetted since 2022 — will handle the distribution.

**UMF WAS ESTABLISHED IN 2022 BY THE** NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINE ASSOCIATIONS DANSKE MEDIER **(DENMARK)**, MEDIEBEDRIFTENES LANDSFORENING **(NORWAY)**, MEDIALIITTO AND UUTISMEDIAN LIITTO **(FINLAND)**, TIDNINGSGIVARNA **(SWEDEN)**, AND BONNIER NEWS GROUP.

**A total of €1.2 million has been raised by UMF and donated to media outlets in Ukraine. The recipients of this aid are selected by UMF and include:**

- The National Union of Journalists of Ukraine (NUJU).
- The Association of Independent Regional Publishers of Ukraine (AIRPU).
- The Ukrainian Media Business Association (UMBA).
- The Lviv Media Forum (LMF).

**Among the initiatives, UMF has so far delivered:**

- 260 solar-powered energy banks.
- 36 power stations.
- 250 iPhones and laptops.
- 85 flak jackets and helmets.
- 48 sleeping bags.
- 400 first aid kits, including tourniquets.
- 40 walkie-talkies and binoculars.
- Safety training in partnership with the 2402 Foundation.
- €825,000 transferred to local Ukrainian media to support:
  - 616 journalists (116 in 2024).
  - 205 media outlets (46 in 2024).
